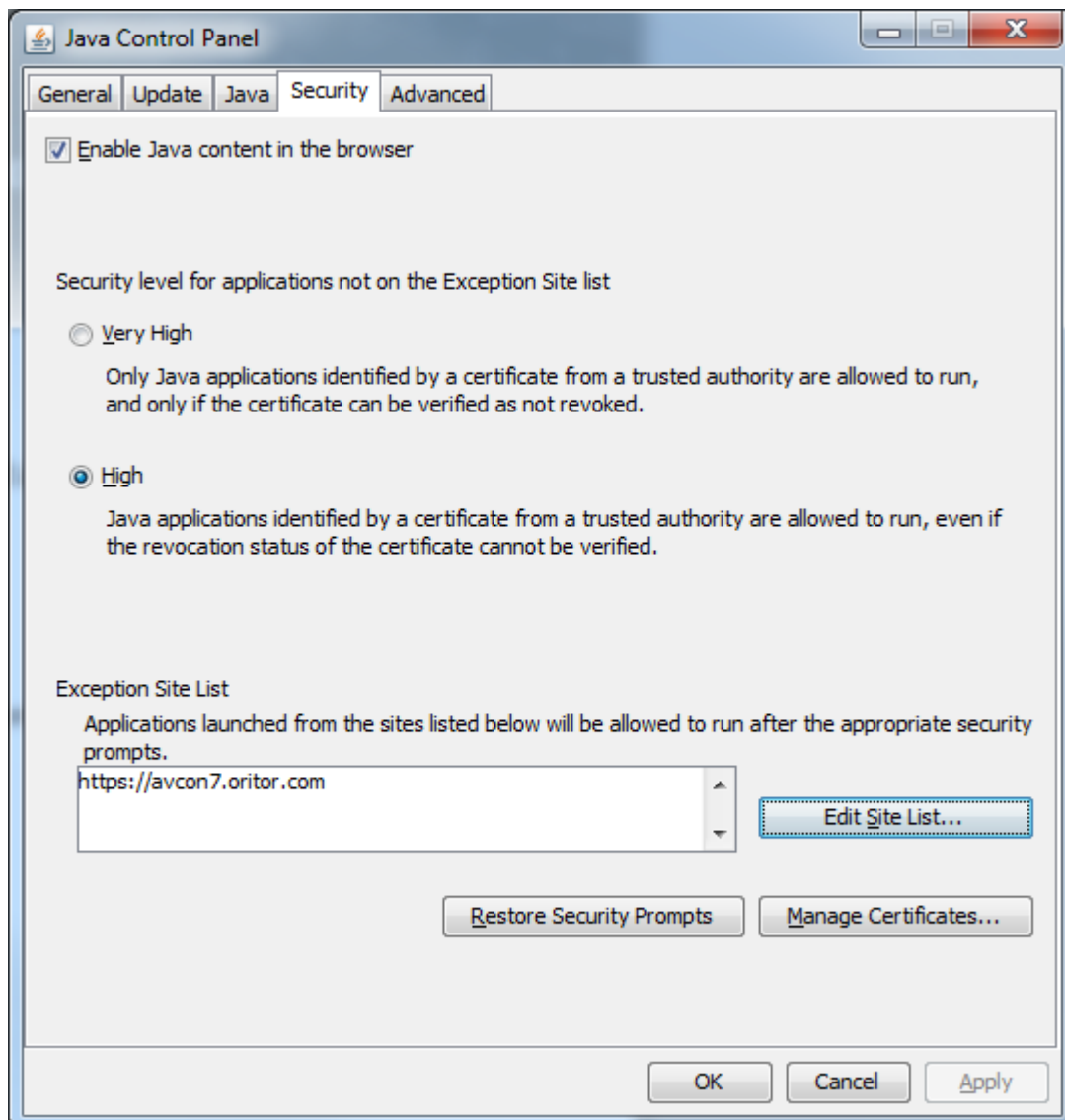


How To – JAVA for 1Click Desktop share (Firefox)

To enable Desktop Share to function you must add an exception to your JAVA security settings. It is advisable to have your JAVA updated to the latest version

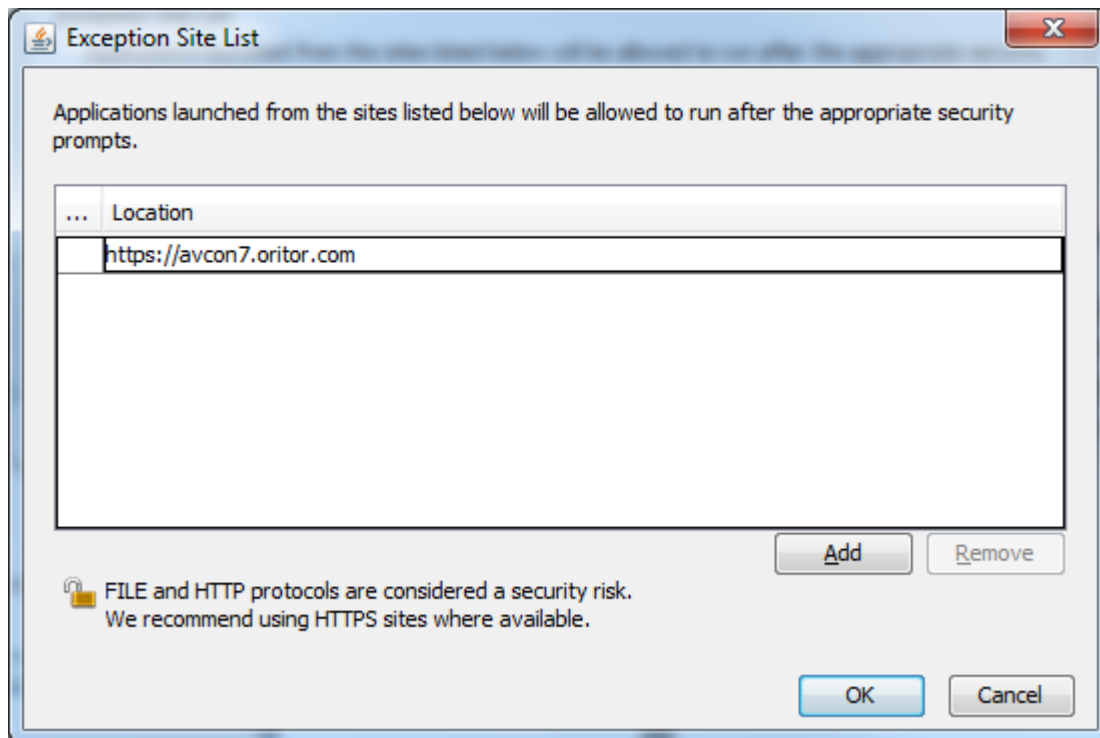
How To:

1. For the first threat analysis line graph:
 - a. From the start menu, navigate to Start > All Programs > Java > Configure Java
 - b. Select the 'Security' tab –

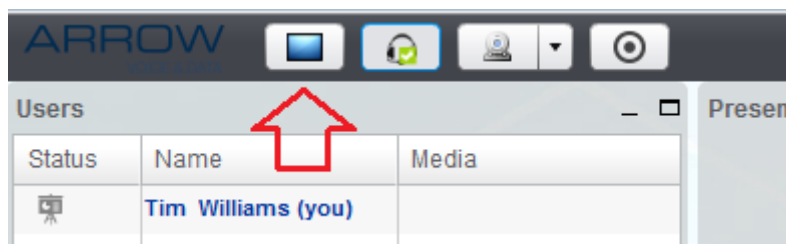
2. Select “Edit Site List” to open up the “Exception Site List”



3. Click the Add button – type in the following location, then select ok:

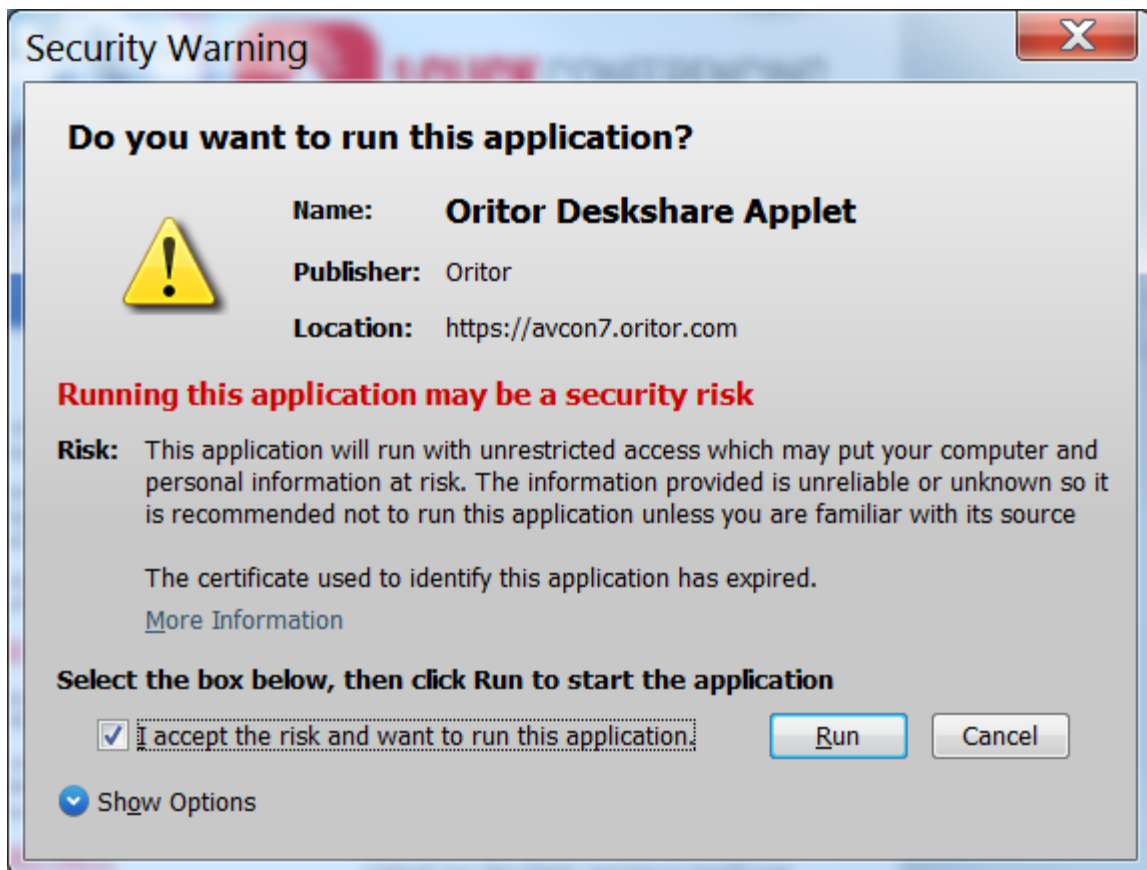

4. Close Java, and reboot your PC and proceed to 1click, open a meeting a select the deskshare button as follows:-

5. Once the Desktop Share window opens, choose Full Desktop or region to initiate the desktop share feature.
6. You may be presented with a Security warning pop-up box asking for permission for the Java plug-in to work, to continue you must acknowledge the pop-up box by ticking the box to run the plug-in, then click Yes/ok as per the below:-



7. 1Click Desktop Share should now function, you will see a blue border/box appear covering either the full Desktop or region of your Desktop that is about to be shared with your participants.
8. You will see the Desktop Share appear in your 1click conference within the Desktop share menu. This is just a small window showing you the content that you are sharing with your participants.
